Sandra L. Brown, M.A., is the author of many books on surviving abusive relationships, including *Women Who Love Psychopaths* and *How to Spot a Dangerous Man*. She has pioneered the field of identifying profiles of women prone to attracting and tolerating narcissists, borderlines, and psychopaths. Her treatment program for "*Healing the Aftermath of Pathological Love Relationships*" is one of the first in the country to address this growing population of untreated women.
